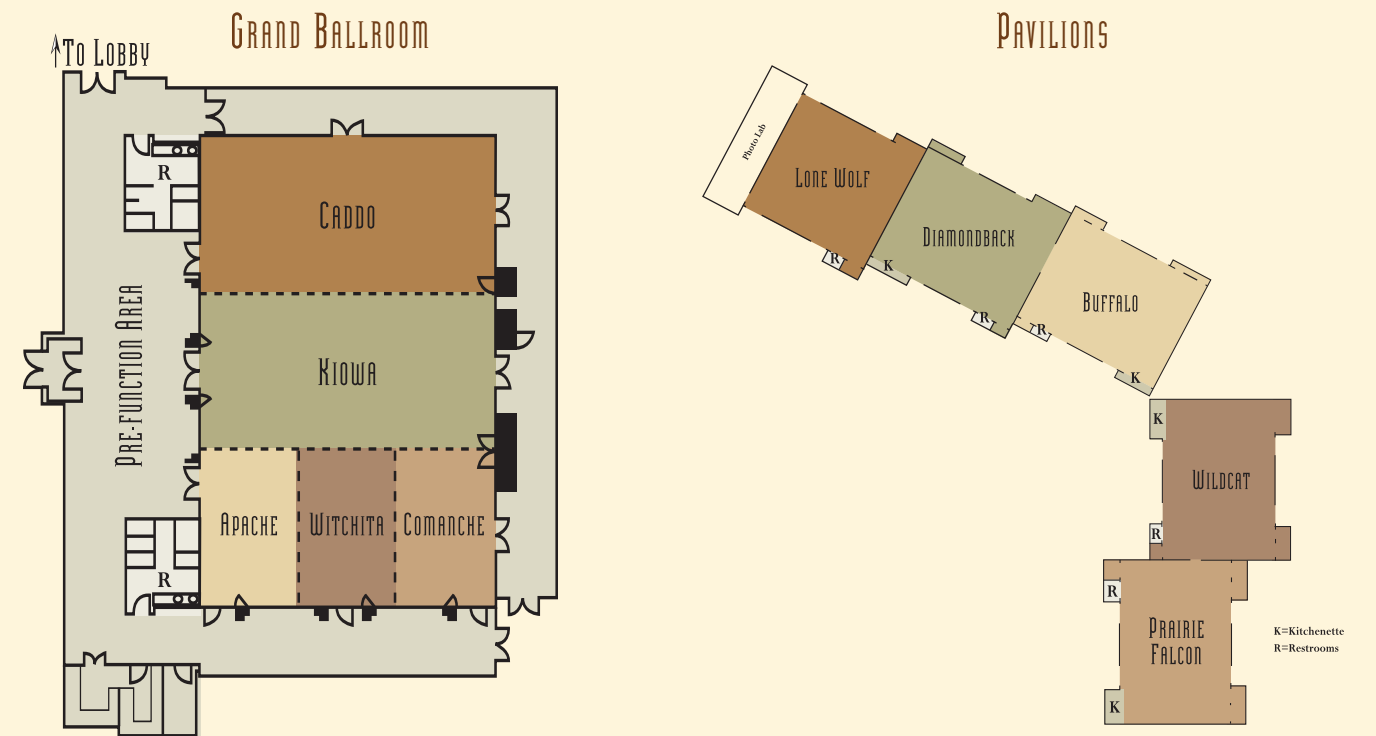
QUARTZ MOUNTAIN SITE PLAN
